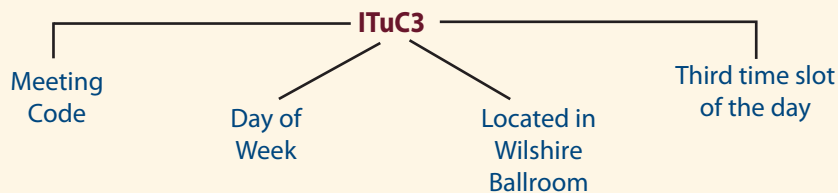

EXPLANATION OF SESSION CODES

The first letter of the code is the meeting: I = FOM/IT. The second letter of the code indicates the day of the week: Tu = Tuesday, W = Wednesday and Thursday. The third letter in the code indicates the location with each letter A–D representing a different meeting room. The number at the end of the code signals whether it is the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th or 5th time slot of each day.
